Discount food buying network takes orders

SHARE is a community-based, volunteer-run nonprofit food-buying network available to anyone who wants to save 30 percent to 50 percent on meat and fresh produce.

SHARE is a community-based, volunteer-run nonprofit food-buying network available to anyone who wants to save 30 percent to 50 percent on meat and fresh produce.

There are no age, income or residency requirements to participate. Orders can be customized by choosing among 20 plus individual items on the order form. Ten of these items are included in packages for a reduced price; a Mini Package is available for \$15, and a Big Value Package for \$25.

Every month there is 9-pound assortment of fresh produce for \$7 and a 10-pound assortment of organic produce for \$15.

Orders can be delivered to homebound shoppers. Food orders are pre-paid with checks, cash, money orders, EBT food stamp funds, and credit or debit cards.

Orders for distribution on Jan. 30 at Peter Rich Community Center may be placed in person today at the Superior Business Center, 1423 N. Eighth St., Superior, or 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday at Peter Rich Community Center, 1201 N. Eighth St., Superior. Online orders may be placed December 10-January 17 at www.sharewi.org.
