

Food-buying club gets Carlton site

The Volunteer Services of Carlton County is partnering with Lake Superior SHARE, a nonprofit food-buying club available to people living within 90 miles of Duluth and Superior.

The Volunteer Services of Carlton County is partnering with Lake Superior SHARE, a nonprofit food-buying club available to people living within 90 miles of Duluth and Superior.

The new partnership will establish a volunteer-run distribution site at Bethesda Evangelical Lutheran Church, 204 Fifth St., Carlton. SHARE (Self-Help and Resource Exchange) already had a distribution site in Superior and announced plans to add sites in Solon Springs, Cloquet and Two Harbors after a News Tribune story generated hundreds of new orders.

SHARE participants pay a set price for a variety of food, which varies from month to month but is usually offered at a 30 percent to 50 percent savings compared to the supermarket price. In March, a \$20 Easter dinner package will be available. Other food packages also will be available.

Volunteers will begin providing the Carlton County service today. Those who placed orders in February will be able to pick up their groceries from 1-2 p.m., and information on the program and March order forms also will be available.
