In her place, Cherrie Kulas has taken over as coordinator for the program. Kulas has been involved with the program for many years, both as a person who received SHARE products and as a volunteer.

"At the time, I had four or five kids, and it helped save money," said Kulas.

When Weisbrod retired, Kulas said she made the decision to step up and take over the program.

"I didn't want to see it disappear," Kulas said. "It's a good program, especially for those who fall between the cracks for getting help through the system."

SHARE is a nonprofit organization that helps residents receive food at 30 percent to 50 percent off of grocery store prices.

"It's something that anyone can use and save some money," Kulas said.

There are no income requirements or membership fees necessary to participate in SHARE.

Participants have the opportunity to buy package deals of food that are either \$15 or \$25, or they can chose individual items. A minimum order of \$15 is required. Fresh fruit and vegetables, frozen meats and canned goods are just some of the items available.

"(SHARE) is a way to get cost-effective groceries," Kulas said. "I would like it to continue and see it grow a little bit."

In addition to a new coordinator, the group also will have a new location for the distribution of SHARE products in Stevens Point – the National Guard Armory, at 3116 Jefferson St.

Kulas and other volunteers work together to coordinate and distribute the orders for the Stevens Point area. Order forms are due June 8 for distribution later that month.
