SHARE, which is active in about 200 communities in the Upper Midwest, promotes volunteerism while providing nutritious products at reduced costs.

Jane Bergmann is leading the volunteer team at Calvary Lutheran Church, 1301 S. Ridge Road. Food ordered this week will be available for pickup at the church from 10 to 11:30 a.m. Jan. 22.

"It's available for anyone," Bergmann said, adding that it is especially helpful to families on tight budgets.

It does not have any income guidelines, membership fees or other eligibility requirements, but all orders must meet a minimum \$15 limit.
