The SHARE Food Buying Club is offering Thanksgiving and **Christmas** dinner packages that contain all of the fixings to prepare a festive spread for a family of six.

The dinner packages cost \$30 each.

The Thanksgiving Dinner Package features a 12-14 pound turkey, lower sodium stuffing mix, cranberry sauce, premium dinner rolls, an 8-inch pumpkin pie, and over 10 pounds of fresh produce including potatoes, celery, acorn squash, apples, oranges and other seasonal varieties (actual selection may vary).

Beginning Oct. 12, families can shop for the Thanksgiving Dinner Package online at www.sharewi.org. The ordering deadline for this package will Nov. 1, and pickup is scheduled for Nov. 19.

SHARE's Christmas Dinner Package includes a 6-pound boneless honey ham, canned pineapple, a sweet potato casserole, premium dinner rolls, an 8-inch apple pie, and over 10 pounds of fresh produce such as potatoes, broccoli, carrots, apples, oranges and more (again,

actual produce selection may vary). Beginning Nov. 9, orders will be accepted online at www.sharewi.org. Orders must be placed by Nov. 29, and pickup is scheduled for Dec. 17.

Orders can be placed immediately by contacting the local SHARE volunteer team at 715-849-8585 or by **calling** SHARE's main office toll-free at 800-548-2124.

Pickup for both meals will be from 6:30 a. m. to 8:30 a.m. at the Mosinee National Guard Armory, 1000 Jackson St.

Volunteers are needed to help unload and distribute the meals, and they will need to report to the Armory at 5 a.m. Those interested may **call** 715-849-8585.

The online ordering system accepts debit and credit card payments only, but SHARE also accepts cash, check, money order and Quest/Link/Bridge (food stamp, EBT or SNAP) cards.
